Plan to arrive at the campsite any time after 1 pm and before 6 pm on Saturday. We will have dinner ready around 7ish.

We will be caving in the morning around 9:30 and leaving the caving site around 2-ish.

When we cave you will get dirty. But hey, that's the fun part!

Camping Packlist:

- Tent (rental can be arranged when you sign up)
- Sleeping Bag or comforter - make sure you are warm it will probably be cold at night
- Sleeping pad or another comforter under you when you sleep - it makes all the difference - be comfy!
- Hiking boots for hiking around the State Park
- Hat for sun
- Clothes for camping and hiking
- Clothes for around camp
- Warm jacket
- Warm hat
- Flashlight
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Personal Meds
- Toiletries
- Rain Jacket - it's possible it will rain
- Water bottle (preferably re-usable)
- Camp Chair
- BYOB (let's keep it under control boys)

Packlist for Caving - the cave is 61° year round:

- Boots or shoes that can get dirty - something with traction - no open toed shoes
- One layer of loose fitting, lightweight grubby clothes. Everything on your body will get dirty and scuffed
- If you have soft knee pads, they aren't a bad idea - not the hard plastic ones though
- Have a COMPLETE change of clothes ready for when you are done caving
- A garbage bag to throw your dirty clothes in afterwards
- A washcloth to clean up with afterwards. There are no showers on the premises but there is a bathroom to get yourself presentable for the drive home
- Food and drinks are not allowed in the cave
